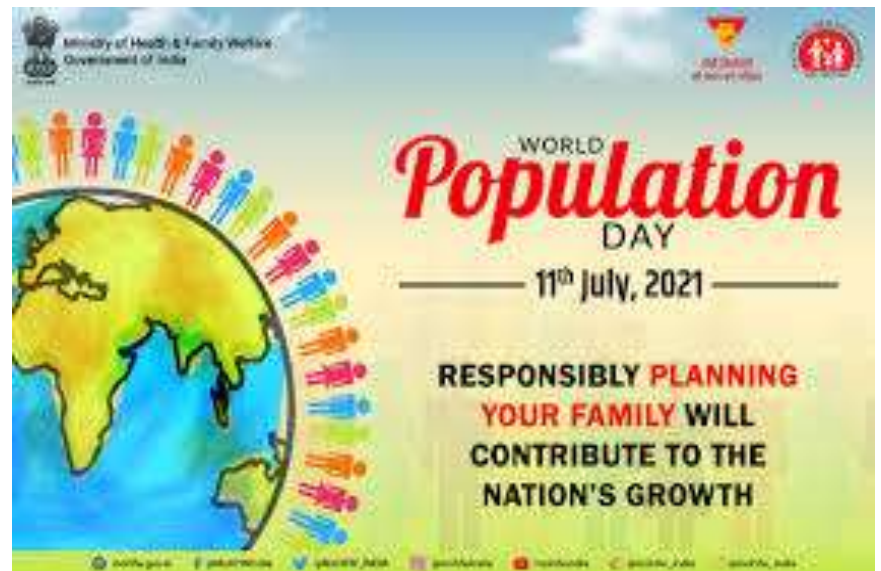

All across India National Doctors' Day is celebrated on July 1 in memory of Dr. Bidhan Chandra Roy, physician and the second Chief Minister of West Bengal. He was born on July 1, 1882 and died on the same date in 1962.

Although supposed to be celebrated by [patients](#) in and benefactors of the [healthcare industry](#), it is usually celebrated by [health care organizations](#). Staff may organize a lunch for doctors during which physicians are presented with tokens of recognition. Historically, a card or red carnation may be sent to physicians and their spouses, along with a flower being placed on the graves of deceased [physicians](#).

World Population Day

World Population Day is an [annual event](#), observed on [July 11](#) every year, which seeks to raise awareness of [global population](#) issues. The event was established by the Governing Council of the [United Nations Development Programme](#) in 1989.




It was inspired by the [public interest](#) in Five Billion Day on July 11, 1987, the approximate date on which the world's population reached five billion people. World Population Day aims to increase people's [awareness](#) on various population issues such as the importance of [family planning](#), [gender equality](#), [poverty](#), [maternal health](#) and [human rights](#).

<p>Madam/Sir,</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">Please refer to the subject cited above.</p> <p>In this regard, attention is invited to the circular dated 23.04.2023 for Scrutiny of Applications for Validation / Joint Options. Vide the said circular it was directed that Applications for Validation / Joint Options in which all information is provided and have been vetted and approved by the employer will be examined for completeness for provided records and in case the records and wage details submitted by the employer match with the field office details, the dues will be calculated and demand letter will be issued to the employer.</p> <p>2. Further, it was also directed that if the Applications for Validation / Joint Options are not approved by the employer or complete information is not provided in the Applications for Validation / Joint Options but approved by the employer, an opportunity will be given to the employer under intimation to the employee/pensioner for providing any additional proof or evidence or correction of any mistake/errors (including those made by the employees/pensioners).</p> <p>3. Therefore, the expeditious disposal of the Applications for Validation of Joint Options/Joint Options from pensioners/ members being submitted by employers and forwarded to Field Offices in the same time as it exists for other claims becomes of utmost importance. However, during regular reviews through VC it has been observed that Demand Letter / Communication to employer has not been issued promptly for cases said to have been scrutinized.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Condt....</p>

4. Hence, it is reiterated that each Applications for Validation of Joint Option/Joint Option shall be scrutinized expeditiously and it shall be ensured that Demand Letter to Employer / Communication to Employer is issued for providing any additional proof or evidence or correct any mistakes/ errors (including made by employers/ pensioners) in respect of each Application for Validation of Joint Option/Joint Option **within 20 days** of receipt of the application in the login of the Dealing Assistant.

5. Further, all Zonal Offices are directed to monitor and ensure the scrutiny of applications within timeline so that Demand Letter to Employer / Communication Letter to Employer for providing any additional proof or evidence or correct any mistakes/ errors is issued without any delay.

Sub: Instructions for regulating joint request under paragraph 26(6) of EPF Scheme 1952- reg.

Madam / Sir,

Please refer to the above subject.

1. Paragraph 26 (6) of the Employees' Provident Funds Scheme, 1952 ("Scheme", hereafter), provides for the enrolment of an employee as a member of the Scheme whose monthly pay is more than the statutory wage ceiling (presently Rs.15,000/- per month), i.e. who is excluded from the mandatory membership of the Scheme. The paragraph also enables a member of the Scheme to contribute on actual (higher) pay in a specified manner.
2. Joint requests under Paragraph 26 (6) will henceforth be made and allowed as follows:
 - a. Any employee who intends to become a member of the Scheme and contribute to it on actual (higher) pay exceeding the statutory limit (presently Rs. 15,000/- p.m.) shall submit a joint request with his employer in the attached *pro forma* application.
 - b. The said joint request will be made through the employer to the jurisdictional Regional Office.
 - c. The employer shall, further, undertake in the attached *pro forma* application to pay the administrative charges as payable on actual (higher) pay and to comply with all statutory provisions in respect of such employee.
3. The manner in which such joint requests will be received and maintained by the EPFO Field Office is as follows:



NOTIFICATIONS/CIRCULARS

- a. The employer shall submit the joint request and the undertaking in the *pro forma* application duly signed by the employee and the employer to the jurisdictional Regional Office digitally. The Regional Office will inform to the establishments under its jurisdiction about such a digital channel.
 - b. All such joint requests and undertakings received by the jurisdictional Regional Office shall be expeditiously processed.
 - c. An officer not below the rank of Assistant Provident Fund Commissioner will allow such member to contribute on actual (higher) pay or enroll such an employee as a member of the Scheme, as the case may be under intimation to the employer and the employee within 7 days of receipt of such joint request.
4. The above instructions are henceforth applicable in respect of the following employees:
- a. who will be enrolled in the Scheme hereafter,
 - b. existing members of the Scheme who may intend to contribute on actual (higher) pay in future when their wages exceed the then existing statutory wage ceiling.
5. All existing members who are already contributing on actual (higher) pay, if they have not submitted their joint requests and undertaking of the employer, can submit the same at the time of final claim settlement.

Subject: Relaxation in eligibility criteria for registering Degree/Diploma pass out as an apprentice under NATS, with in of 5 years from the date of passing of qualifying examination.

Dear Sirs,

You are aware that presently a candidate can join as Apprentice under National Apprenticeship Scheme (NATS) within 03 years from the date of passing the qualifying examination. This criterion was adopted based on a recommendation made by Central Apprenticeship Council in its 26th meeting held on 29/11/1995.

2. For providing the benefit of the Scheme to more students especially those from remote and backward areas, it has been decided to relax the eligibility criteria for registering Degree/Diploma pass-outs as an apprentice under NATS from 03 years to 05 years form the date of passing the qualifying examination and date of joining the apprenticeship training.

3. This will be applicable from the date of this letter. You are requested widely publicize the relaxation amongst all stakeholders.
